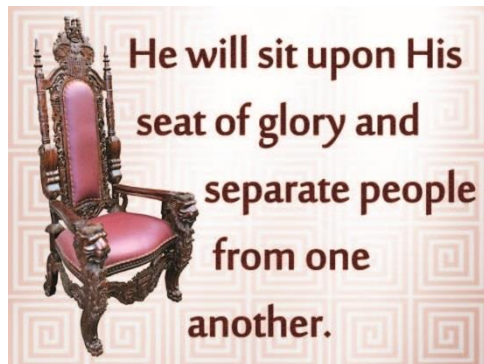

A NOTE FROM FR. KEEHNER

When I came to St. Christine Parish in 2012, I was surprised to find a monthly envelope in the collection packet set aside for Bereavement Luncheons. When I asked what this was for it was explained to me that this money goes toward expenses incurred by the parish for bereavement luncheons, such as the cost for setting up and cleaning up, supplies (cups, napkins, cake plates and forks, coffee and tea, and table linens). It does not, however, pay for the actual luncheon, something which we have recently learned is not clear to everyone. In order to avoid any confusion in this regard in the future, we are discontinuing this envelope, please just add it to your regular weekly or monthly collection so that we can continue this important ministry of making our parish center available, free of charge, to families who are grieving the loss of a loved one.
